TRYOUT PROCESS ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

Parents must attest they have attended this Tryout meeting or watched a video of this meeting thereof. No player may go on the ice until this is completed and submitted to your Divisional Coordinator.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Parents must abide by the code of conduct and waivers that you accepted during our Tryout Registration Process, any inappropriate parent or player behaviour during our Tryout process will result in immediate loss of privilege to attend **any** ice arena until a disciplinary meeting has been convened.

DIVISIONAL COORDINATORS

These volunteers will act as your key liaison until team rosters are announced and Team Manager is appointed.



WHY DO WE USE A POOL AND B POOL?

- Psychological to indicate A1 and A2 teams are not yet formed
- A Pool is a larger group being evaluated for A1 Team roster
- B Pool is a larger group being evaluated for A2 Team roster
- Everyone starts in the B Pool as per Hockey Canada best practice
- Early promotion to A Pool designed for big tryout groups and to give MORE ICE TIME and evaluation opportunity to kids that could be placed in either A Pool or B Pool (commonly referred to as the "bubble")

PREPARING EVERYONE FOR TRYOUTS ...

- Prepare for a long and arduous (but thorough) process often lasting 3 weeks for A Pool, 4 weeks for B Pool
- Expectations of both player and parents need to be well managed from outset and during the process
- Some of you will be disappointed!




PROMOTE 0-10 SKATERS + 1 GOALIE TO A POOL

PRE-TRYOUTS (U11)

- Minimum of 2 Optional Development Ice Times (Aug 28-31) for both Skaters and Goalies
- Minimum of 4 Development Ice Times before evaluation (After Sept 5)
- Tryouts will not start until after return to school

GOALIES (U11)

- 1 Skills Evaluation sessions with Assertion Goaltending
- Minimum 4 ice times will be offered in Sept
- Goalies now also evaluated in Scrimmages
- Start in B Pool but opportunity to be selected to A Pool early
- A Pool Goalies should expect minimum 2 Exhibition games in Sept

SKATERS (U11)

- Minimum 4 ice times will be offered before A Pool is finalized
- Start in B Pool but opportunity to be selected to A Pool early
- A Pool Skaters should expect minimum 2 Exhibition games in Sept



GOALIES (U13-U15-U18)

- Minimum 2 Skills Evaluation sessions with Assertion Goaltending
- Minimum 4 ice times offered before A Pool is finalized
- Now also evaluated in Scrimmages
- Start in B Pool but opportunity to be selected to A Pool early
- A Pool Goalies should expect Minimum 2 Exhibition games in Sept

SKATERS (U13-U15-U18)

- Minimum 4 ice times offered before A Pool is finalized
- Start in B Pool but opportunity to be selected to A Pool early
- A Pool Skaters should expect Minimum 2 Exhibition games in Sept

INJURED PLAYERS (U11-U13-U15-U18)

 Selection Committee will make an assessment based on the anticipated level of player, severity of injury and date of return to play. Injured players unable to participate in Tryouts may be rendered ineligible for A Pool selection.



INDEPENDENT EVALUATORS

- In 2022 Independent Evaluators were observed to have low engagement
- Where possible our paid coaches will together participate in player evaluation and also our selection committee *where they do not have a kid in the association
- High probability that past and future coaches can now together debate a player's performance, trajectory and appropriate Pool placement

REFUND POLICY 2023

- If we are UNABLE to form an A2 Team, all registered Tryout players NOT selected for the A Pool will receive a refund of their Tryout fees
- Players selected for A Pool will be ineligible for refund
- If we do form an A2 Team, no players will be eligible for refund

APPEALS PROCESS

- A player may appeal within 48 hours of notification of release. The notice of appeal must be in writing and directed to the President.
